With an expected attendance of 1000 we ask that food stalls:

- Remain open for the duration of the festival (10.30am – 11pm 21<sup>st</sup> March 2020).
- Consider the environment and minimise waste, packaging and single use containers
- Use our free crockery, cutlery and washing up facility
- Do not sell cold drinks, as the Eel Festival will once again be providing cold drinks at their 'Refresher Marquee', which is a fundraiser for the festival
- Are set up with site cleared by 10.15am on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2020
- All extension cords inspected and tagged prior to festival
- Gas bottles firmly secured

#### SATURDAY SET-UP:

You will need to provide your own shelter as well as tables, cooking appliances, extension cords, lights and display equipment. Mains power is limited and we prefer that you use gas or generator for cooking. No tagging of cords will be available at the festival so please ensure this is done as access to site will be denied if electrical cords have not been tagged. Access to the site will be available from 9am. If earlier access required, please advise. All sites must be ready for operation by 10.15am which includes all vehicles removed from site, except catering vans. Food stalls are expected to stay open late to cater for the evening audience which includes those requiring food and coffee at the end of the festival. We understand if other stalls wish to close at dusk but encourage stall holders to enjoy a "night market" atmosphere.

#### WASTE MANAGEMENT:

As part of our commitment to protecting the environment, the Festival aims to minimise litter and reduce landfill. Festival calico bags will be available for purchase. Consider ways of reducing your packaging by not offering straws or lids and providing condiments in bulk dispensers. **Polystyrene and non-recyclable plastic are not acceptable.** Please use festival provided plates and cutlery where possible. Washing stand will be located in close proximity to stalls/main area.

#### FOOD PERMITS:

If not currently registered with Ararat Rural City, catering stalls will need to obtain a Temporary Food Event permit. Details are included on the Stall Holder Application form.

**PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE:** All stallholders are required to hold their own public liability insurance. A copy of your certificate of currency must be included with this application

**FEES:** For general stall holders the fee \$55 for a site up to 3m x 6m- no power is available for these sites. For food stalls/caterers the fee is \$165 per site. An extra \$55 is payable for any stallholder requiring power other than for lighting. Fee includes entry to Saturday's Festival for 2 people. These fees are inclusive of GST.
